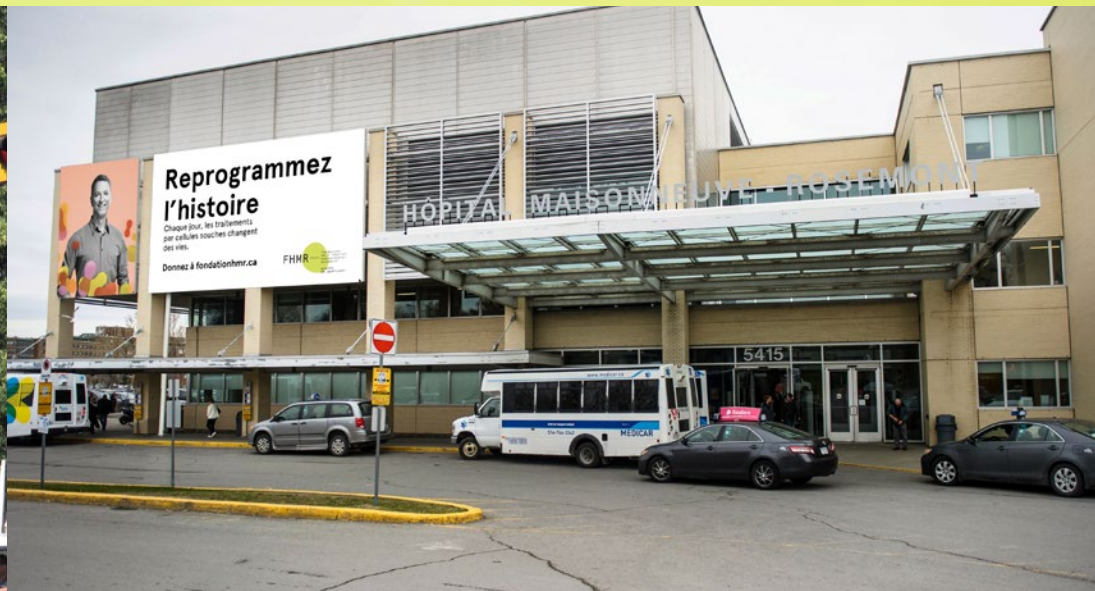

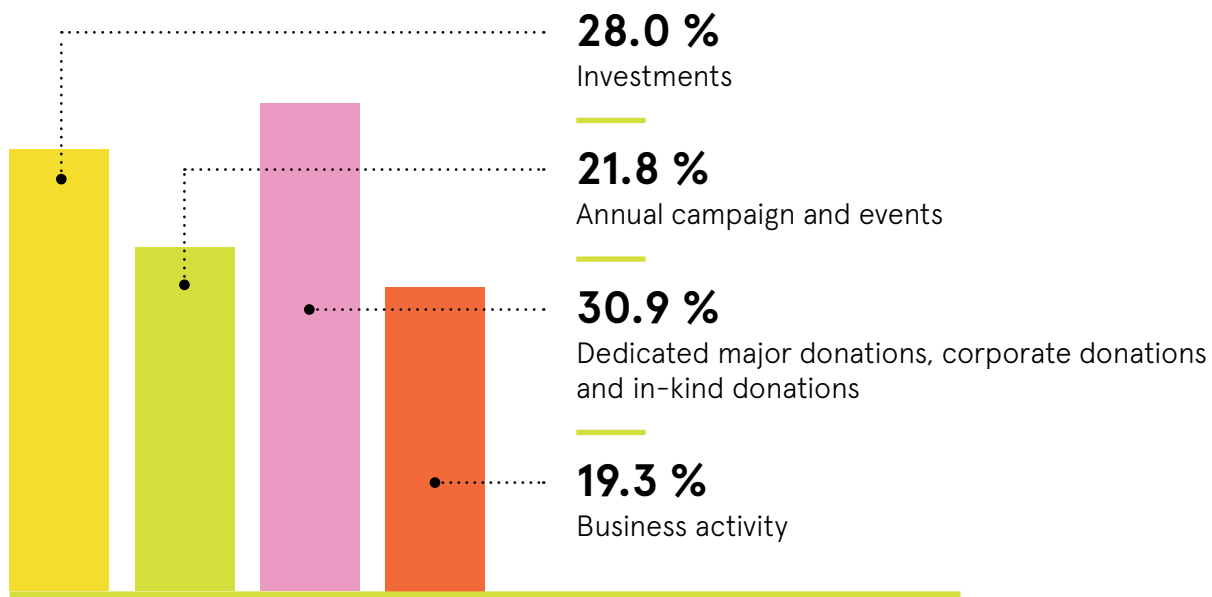

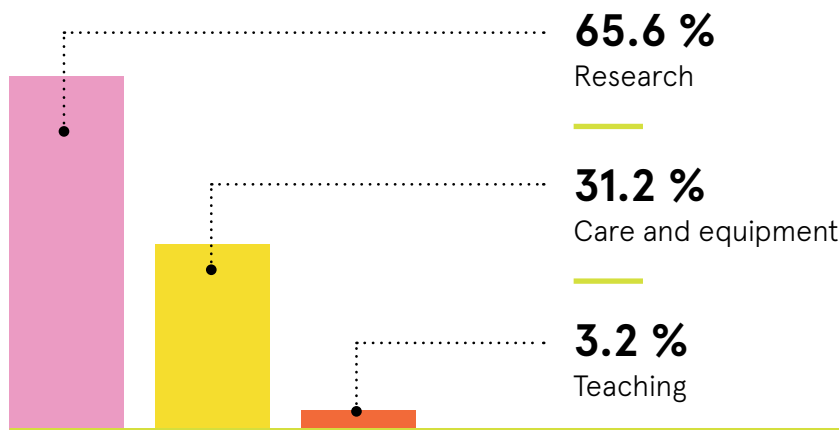

It’s cold, but **Parnell** is happy. Incredibly happy! There he stands with his 10-year-old daughter **Alicia** at the 1K start line. He’s taking stock of how far he’s come, smiling and enjoying just being there and having the chance to walk with her along with thousands of other runners.

Flashback. It’s 2016, and **Parnell** learns that he has a large brain tumour. He will undergo several successful operations. Throughout his hospital stays, he is greatly touched by how caring, supportive and dedicated the entire Radiation Oncology team is. Thus, once his health recovered, he

decided to get involved to give back some of the love he received. It is what gave him the desire and the strength to fight and guided him towards healing.

Today, **Parnell** is back at work as a financial advisor. In addition to the Scotiabank Charity Challenge, which he wants to run again with his daughter, this time in the 5K distance, he volunteers with his friends in many environmental and social projects. For example, he sometimes rides a bicycle taxi in the East end of Montreal. He dreams of raising funds for the well-being of HMR patients and would like to organize an event at Bout-de-l’île Park to showcase the activities that can be done there in winter.

CHEMOBRAIN PROJECT

\$142,174

Financing the development of the Signature Bank of the *Centre de recherche de l'Institut universitaire en santé mentale de Montréal*. This bank, the largest compilation of biological, psychosocial and clinical data on people with mental health problems, contributes to significant advances in knowledge about mental illnesses and cognitive disorders associated with cancer.

UVEITIS PROJECT

\$65,000

Training of a clinical fellow for ophthalmic research.

OPHTHALMOLOGY

\$7,380

Acquisition, with other partners, of a specular microscope for the Quebec Eye Bank located at Hôpital Maisonneuve-Rosemont. Specular microscopy makes it possible to observe the endothelium of the cornea.

TELEMEDECINE

\$288,428

Funding of a program to enhance the skills of ophthalmic nurses in order to improve access to specialized services for certain patients.

ORTHOPAEDICS AND SPORTS MEDICINE

\$45,000

Funding for an innovative system to reduce wait times and ensure better patient follow-up.



CAR-T cells or the birth of a new therapeutic era

“CAR-T cell therapy marks the beginning of a new therapeutic era. It offers a personalised therapy that capitalises on the patient’s own immune system.”

Since the fall of 2019, the Hôpital Maisonneuve-Rosemont (HMR) has – and it is a first in Canada – a revolutionary new treatment option for blood cancer: CAR¹-T-Cells.

Unique in Canada

This program, led by the team of **Dr. Isabelle Fleury**, hemato-oncologist and head of the Lymphoma Clinic at HMR, breaks new ground by combining the patient’s immune cells with innovative genetic modification technology.

A therapeutic alternative

Normally, these cancers are eradicated by chemotherapy or radiotherapy. A stem cell transplant can complete the treatment. In this case, the patient’s immune system is replaced by that of the donor. However, sometimes this is not enough, and the cancer comes back.

With CAR-T cell therapy, white blood cells or, more precisely, T-lymphocytes, which normally assist the immune system in fighting infections, are used. In the case of CAR-T therapy, these cells are extracted and then, through genetic manipulation, they are modified to recognize cancer cells. Then, we multiply them to get enough to fight the cancer. Once ready, we reinject the patient with his or her own cells, which are now modified and “armed” to destroy the cancer cells.

What’s next?

HMR is the only centre to offer this treatment option to adult patients whose disease is refractory to conventional treatments. Currently, the genetic manipulation is done in the United States and the final product is returned to the HMR for infusion, where the bag of cells is injected into the patient’s veins. The HMR is working to ensure that the whole process of genetic manipulation can be performed within its own Centre for Excellence in Cellular Therapy (CECT) – funded in part by the Foundation – in the near future.

OPHTHALMOLOGY

\$63,330

Funding for **Dr. Mike Sapiuha's** research on the causes of blindness due to diabetic retinopathy. This project aims to develop a new therapeutic approach to regenerate the retina naturally by stimulating the development of new functional blood vessels in the retina.

EAR, NOSE AND THROAT TRAINING

\$71,922

These funds are used to support clinical and fundamental research, to develop training programs, to purchase specimens, and to cover the cost of statistical services.

ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE

\$300,000

Dr. Gilbert Bernier and his team are working to improve their understanding of the disease and to develop an effective treatment for it.

IMMUNO-ONCOLOGY

\$106,798

For the Myeloma Canada Chair of **Dr. Richard Leblanc**. This philanthropic chair, funded by donations from organizations, corporations and individuals, has three objectives: to fund basic and clinical research; to improve patient care; and to promote the dissemination of knowledge.

OPHTHALMOLOGY

\$180,500

This project, led by **Dr. Cynthia Qian**, aims to better understand and prevent the effects of Stickler's Syndrome, a rare genetic disease of connective tissue with multiple consequences. This project was funded thanks to the generosity of the Paul-A. Fournier Foundation

Since January 2019, **Marion** has been part of **Dr. Heather Melichar**'s team in immunology-oncology. It was her passion and curiosity that led her to do a second postdoctoral fellowship with the aim of developing the first preclinical model, in mice, of a highly lethal leukemia. The HMR Foundation recently awarded her a grant of more than \$30,000 to fund her research.

With this support, she can concentrate on her work, without worrying about monetary issues.

“It is thanks to grants that we can focus on what really matters and work without pressure. We don't have to seek funding based on findings and our publications.”

Daily, **Marion** tries to reproduce, as faithfully as possible, a particularly aggressive form of leukemia mostly found in children. Upon conclusion of her research, she hopes to have a model so like that of humans that it could be used to identify new therapeutic targets and test new drugs. It is the first step leading to clinical trials in humans and experimental treatments, and eventually a cure for patients. These stages of research are essential and unfortunately sometimes forgotten, hence the importance of funding.

“Les Amis de Jean-François”: 25 years of commitment to sick children

In 2019, “Les Amis de Jean-François” celebrated its 25th anniversary. A look back at a quarter-century of involvement, commitment and action that has developed over the years into a special relationship with the Hôpital Maisonneuve-Rosemont (HMR) and its Foundation.

HOW IT ALL STARTED

In 1991, three-year-old Jean-François was diagnosed with leukemia and died after three years of treatment. His parents, supported by family and friends, made a commitment to help sick children and improve their quality of life. They created “Les Amis de Jean-François”, to pay tribute and perpetuate the memory of their son.

AN IMPRESSIVE RECORD!

Since then, they have donated close to one million dollars and financed several projects, including: the development of existing spaces and facilities (isolation room, section of the Department of Paediatrics, etc.), and the purchase of materials and equipment for Paediatrics and Neonatology (ultrasound machines, heated beds, cardiac monitors, treatment chairs, equipment, etc.).

AND THERE’S MORE TO COME!

As part of their 25th anniversary, “Les Amis de Jean-François” are combining their efforts to take advantage of the technological developments of the last few years to prepare children for difficult medical examinations by giving them access to the virtual world, allowing them to explore, discover and tame the hospital environment.

Today, in addition to **Camille Thibodeau**, **Pierre Dubois**, and their children, **Marc-André** and **Julien**, “Les Amis de Jean-François” regroups more than 1,600 donors; its annual newsletter is sent out to close to 400 people; and all donations are directed to the well-being of the young patients of the HMR without any administrative fees being applied.
