The **Lalema** company donated more than 200 litres of disinfectant to the HMR! This liquid gold has been vital to the Hospital during this


## Financial statements

In this unique year, **35.9%** of revenue was dedicated to the purchase of equipment, funding projects improving **patient care**, **research**, and teaching and **skills development**.



## YOUR DONATIONS GIVE RISE TO GREAT STORIES, LIKE THAT OF FRANÇOIS QUENOT

Unwittingly, François Quenot was a front row witness to this pandemic that hit us as hard as it turned his life upside down.

With the help of his wife **Geneviève**, he was able and willing to share almost every moment of this ordeal in a series of articles and to recount it at our À *Votre Santé!* and *Montréal Passion Vin* events. He was also kind enough to become one of the faces of the *Together for the HMR* Fund.

His story is so incredible that it caught the eye of the media and was featured in an episode of the *De garde 24/7* TV series.

It all started with a trip to France during which **François** contracted COVID. Back in Canada, it takes him a while to figure out that he is affected by this hellish virus that everyone is talking about. Thus, it was that one evening in March, he arrived unconscious and intubated at the Intensive Care Unit of Hôpital Maisonneuve-Rosemont. He then began a long, very long, epic, relentless fight against the disease. A fight for which he has no memory of the first few weeks, as he was unconscious.

Refusing to give up, showing an incredible resilience, surrounded and accompanied by his new family, the intensive care team, he eventually came out of his coma in May, and gradually regained his strength. **François** finally left Hôpital Maisonneuve-Rosemont in June, to begin a long rehabilitation. He is now doing much better.

# Some of the patient care projects SUPPORTED THANKS TO YOUR DONATIONS IN 2020

## **TELEMEDECINE** \$77,046

Development of tele-screening programs for diabetic retinopathy and macular degeneration due to age in the Department of Ophthalmology, thanks to the support of **Jean Turmel** and the **Fondation Jean-Louis Lévesque**.

These advances will translate into improved preventive screening and early treatment, especially in the context of a pandemic, as well as the maintenance of independence for the many patients suffering from these conditions.

# PHYSIOTHERAPY \$5,000

Acquisition of physiotherapy equipment to help hospitalized patients fight against muscle loss and deconditioning, a major challenge in the context of a pandemic. Thanks to **Rio Tinto**, these patients can develop and maintain their physical abilities without leaving their room, helping to reduce pain, anxiety, and stress.

## **OPHTHALMOLOGY** \$86,312


A donation from **Denyse Pharand-L'Écuyer** and **Bernard L'Écuyer**, complemented by government funding, supported
the acquisition of a state-of-the-art imaging device that
facilitates detailed examination of the retina and early
detection of eye diseases such as glaucoma, age-related
macular degeneration, and corneal cancer.

# **OBSTETRICS/GYNECOLOGY** \$138,493

A new software enables the monitoring of pregnant women using data collected by obstetric ultrasound machines at the outpatient gyneco-obstetrics clinic of the HMR Ambulatory Care Centre. It brings together all exams, results, and images in a single, comprehensive view for all of our patients.

#### NEONATALOGY \$36,360

An electrocardiogram offered by **Opération Enfant Soleil** and eight new specialized beds allow the Neonatology Department to provide better care to premature newborns, enhancing the safety and quality of care for these vulnerable patients.



# BLOOD DISEASES: A WORLD FIRST THANKS TO YOUR SUPPORT

Just as there is not one, but many cancers, there is no single way to fight blood diseases. Research is constantly underway to find new therapies. The HMR is no exception and its Research Centre is even considered a reference in this field. For example, a patient suffering from a rare form of blood disease—aplastic anemia— and unresponsive to conventional treatment, had his life saved thanks to a transplant "improved" by the addition of a molecule created in Montreal.

#### Cord transplant and UM171: A miracle cocktail

The team of **Dr. Jean Roy**, hematologist, clinical researcher at the HMR, and full professor at the Faculty of Medicine of the Université de Montréal (UdeM), resorted to a stem cell transplant, using cells extracted from an umbilical cord. These were then "doped" or amplified, as scientists like to say, by a close to miraculous molecule, developed at the UdeM and named UM171.

This molecule has the power to multiply umbilical cord stem cells by a factor of about 50. This makes transplantation safer, especially for adult patients.

It sounds simple, but it is in fact a world first. It is the result of work carried out by a team of researchers from the Institute of Hematology-Oncology and Cellular Therapy at the HMR and the Institute for Research in Immunology and Cancer at the UdeM, whose research efforts have benefited greatly from the support of the HMR Foundation and its donors.

#### Reprogramming patient histories

This work demonstrates the importance and power of cell therapy and stem cell treatments. They represent the medicine of tomorrow, one that is already saving lives today. A medicine with a bright future, offering hope and cure.

"It was after we had exhausted all our treatment options that the UM171 molecule, which had already proven itself in a clinical trial with blood cancer patients, came into play.

In addition to increasing the number of stem cells, UM171 dramatically decreases the risk of long-term immunological complications."

## QUEBEC LEUKEMIA CELL BANK (QLCB) \$100,000

SUPPORTED BY YOUR

**DONATIONS IN 2020** 

A major donation of \$600,000 over three years from the **Cole Foundation** and the **Sandra and Alain Bouchard Foundation** funds the ongoing development of the QLCB biobank in support of research on pediatric and young adult acute leukemia. The ultimate goal is to develop more effective and less toxic treatments for these patients.

### OPHTHALMOLOGY \$144,441

Support of the Caroline Durand Chair in Cellular Therapy for Eye Diseases, held by Dr. May Griffith. With a focus on harnessing the full potential of stem cell treatments in ophthalmology, the Chair empowered Dr. Griffith and her team to develop a revolutionary treatment to cure corneal perforations without transplantation.

# \$100,000

In support of CellCAN, a network created by Canadian researchers to strengthen knowledge transfer and promote the advancement of research and clinical development in the field of regenerative medicine and cell therapy. CellCAN brings together Canada's leading centres for cell therapy, including the HMR's Centre of Excellence in Cell Therapy.

# **SCREENING AND ANALYSIS** \$277,954

Acquisition, replacement, and rental of equipment for the HMR Research Centre in order to maintain and increase HMR's screening and analysis capacities, which were extensively relied upon during the pandemic. This includes table-top refrigerated microcentrifuges, CO<sub>2</sub> incubators, freezers, a biological safety hood, as well as cell analyzers.

### INNOVATION \$319,898

As a contribution to salaries and seed funding for researchers at the HMR Research Centre. These funds support the advancement of research, give researchers the opportunity to explore as yet untapped avenues, and early-career researchers to quickly launch their research program. In addition to fuelling innovation, the support granted has a leverage effect in obtaining public research funds.

# YOUR DONATIONS ENHANCE THE EXPERTISE OF OUR HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS

Thanks to a donation from **Trudi and David Berger**, the Plastic Surgery Division of the HMR acquired a state-of-the-art **Leica microscope**, providing new opportunities for training and surgery.

"Our other microscopes are old models from operating rooms that date back several years. They do not have two eyepieces and cannot zoom or focus like the one just purchased. On the Leica, the optics are of high quality and the visualization of the structures is thus much better."

Allowing realistic simulation of surgeries, this device has several advantages that take training to another level. For example, it is possible to broadcast the intervention on screens and to record it. Teams can watch and review their performance, comment on it, study it, etc.

"With the Leica microscope, residents and experienced surgeons benefit from an unparalleled tool. This greatly improves the quality of training in our establishment."

It reinforces the HMR's status as a centre of excellence in teaching, allowing residents in plastic surgery, otolaryngology, and cardiac surgery to benefit from cutting-edge knowledge in microsurgery.

Professionals are not the only ones who benefit from the Leica microscope; it also has a positive impact on patients. With this tool, surgeons can hone their expertise and are now even more able to operate on complex cases with confidence.

# Some of the training projects

SUPPORTED BY YOUR DONATIONS IN 2020

### RECRUITING SCOLARSHIPS FOR THE RESEARCH CENTRE \$78,788

Support for the next generation of medical professionals through scholarships and internships offered to undergraduate, graduate, and postdoctoral students.

## QUEBEC SARCOMA NETWORK \$5,865

Creation of a website for the HMR's Department of Orthopedics-Oncology, one of three reference centres specializing in the treatment of musculoskeletal tumors in Quebec. This website promotes knowledge transfer and improves the Quebec sarcoma referral system.

# \$120,000

Two new high-fidelity simulation dummies (one for adults and one for children) will help train healthcare personnel, including intensive care staff, in performing invasive and risky procedures, such as those required by patients with COVID.

"We are glad that students, residents, and surgeons can count on equipment at the cutting edge of technology. It makes a difference for them, and for patients as well." 





This state-of-the-art imaging device facilitates detailed examination of the retina and will enhance pathology detection, disease management and patient flow. It will also prove essential in the early detection and accurate diagnosis of a large number of ocular diseases, including age-related macular degeneration.


